1. ATRIAL SEPTAL DEFECT (LARGE OSTIUM SECUNDUM)
2. ASD CLOSURE (22/12/21)

CLINICAL HISTORY

Chief Complaints:

History:

This child has uneventful perinatal period and was gaining weight adequately. He was accidentally found to increased precordial activity in regular visit at 1 year of age. Eco evaluation showed Os ASD with left to right shunt. He was followed up in SRH since then and planned for rsurgical correction in view of dilated RA AND RV.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

Pulse: 99/min. BP: 102/75 mmHg Weight: 12.8 Kg. Height: 98 cm.

General examination:

Child was conscious, oriented, afebrile.

No pallor, icterus, clubbing, cyanosis, lymphadenopathy or oedema.

Systemic examination:

RS - Chest clear bilaterally. Air entry equal. No crepitations or wheeze. maintaining spo2 on RA

CVS - wide fixed split s2. systolic murmur heard.

P/A - Abdomen is soft, not tender and not distended. No hepatosplenomegaly. Bowel sounds are normal.

CNS - Child was conscious and oriented. Muscle tone and reflexes are normal. Plantars are down-going. No signs of meningeal irritation. Pupils are normal sized and normally reactive to light bilaterally

TREATMENT GIVEN

1. inj supacef.
2. in pantoacid
3. inj PCM
4. inj lasix

CLINICAL SUMMARY

Child was admitted and after pre-operative workup, child was taken up for procedure. Child was shifted to PCS ICU for further management..

Hemodynamics: Child required SNP support for hypertension for a breif period which was stoppd on POD 0. He remained hemodynamically stable.

Respiratory: Child was received extubated, on O2 by mask which was weaned on POD1.

Infection: antibiotics were given as per protocol.

Gastrointestinal and nutrition: feed started on POD 0 and increased. child is tolerating feeds and passing stool normally.
Neurological: Child remained stable with no significant past history.

Renal: No issues during stay.

Present status: Currently patient is haemodynamically stable, maintaining saturation on room air without any distress, accepting feed orally and is being discharged with advice to follow-up.

Predischarge weight- 12.5kg

Predischarge ECHO - no residual shunt, mild TR PG-20 mmHg, NO MR, trace pericardial effusion posterior to LV, NO PAH, GOOD BV function.

DISCHARGE ADVICE

NON CARDIAC MEDICATIONS -

1. SYRUP CALPOL (240MG/5ML) 4 ML P/O THRICE A DAY FOR 3 DAYS F/B SOS (For pain and temperature >100°F)
2. SYRUP CALCIMAX PLUS 5 ML P/O TWICE A DAY
3. SYP ZINCOVIT 2.5 ML P/O ONCE A DAY
4. SYP BEVON 5ML ONCE A DAY

VACCINATION - TO BE RESUMED AFTER 6 WEEKS
